April 5, 1927 was the premiere of the NBC ORANGE NETWORK on seven Pacific Coast stations. The National Broadcasting Co. was the first network in the West.

The 3 hour inauguration began at 8:00 P.M. from NBC San Francisco studios, moving to Los Angeles studios in the 2nd hour and back to San Francisco in the 3rd hour from the St. Francis Hotel. This was before the link to New York. The stations were:

KFI Los Angeles

KPO San Francisco (later becoming KNBR)

KGO Oakland

KOMO Seattle

KFOA Seattle (later becoming KOL)

KGW Portland

KHQ Spokane
